WHAT IS IT?

HIGH-FREQUENCY LANGUAGE AND SPEECH SUPPORT Our week-long play-based camps are the perfect environment to provide a high dosage of communication support. Why play-based? Kids learn best through play! We optimize the learning context for children to acquire new speech, language, and social skills.



Spring is full of lots of fun. Campers will love to explore our spring toys and games. Let's learn about things that grow, baby animals, and the way the weather changes.

A VARIETY OF ENGAGING LEARNING ACTIVITIES

The intensive will build skills in turn-taking, clear communication, flexible thinking, executive functioning, and more. There will also be a snack, outdoor play, and lunch time.











A FOCUS ON SKILLS ACROSS SETTINGS

Each child will have SLP-led group therapy as well as one-onone SLP intervention time to target individualized goals to help expand their language and communication.











LOGISTICS



DATE: April 20th - 24th **TIME:** 9:00am - 1:00pm

Free parking is available on side streets (e.g., Gould Road).

Drop off: Please do not drop your child off earlier than 9:00AM. We will be getting our activities for the day ready prior to 9:00AM.
Pick up: Please be back on the premises for pick up no later than 12:55 to ensure your child is picked up promptly at 1:00PM. Aftercare is <u>not</u> available for this intensive.
We ask that families <u>commit to the whole week</u> and to please <u>adhere</u> <u>to the drop-off/pick-up times</u> . This is not just for your child but so that all the children can benefit from a group experience with peers and so that we minimize additional transitions during the group time. Thank you for understanding.
A bathroom is located on site for children who are toilet-trained and can use the bathroom (independently or with supervision).





HOW TO PREPARE

Prepare to get messy. Our activities will include sensory play, water play, and art. Dress your child appropriately and pack an extra pair of clothes (just in case!)	C>2/1/2
Let your child know that they will be going to a fun class where they will get to play with other kids and a new teacher. Share the theme to get them extra excited about the activities.	
Let your child know that you will be dropping them off and picking them up! If drop-offs are tough, please take a look at our drop-off handout for ideas on how to prepare	
Please pack a morning snack, lunch, and water for your child each day. We will let you know as we get closer if there are any allergies to consider. Please <i>label</i> your child's food.	
We are planning to spend our day outside , so please sunscreen your child in the morning prior to arrival. If you want us to reapply, please bring your own labeled sunscreen. Also, bring a <i>hat</i> !	





DAILY AGENDA 9:00AM - 1:00PM

Circle Time

A short structured time where kids can introduce themselves, listen to our story, and sing a song.

Group Therapy Activities

Each day, some themed activities will be set up around the room for children to explore during group play with support from one of our clinicians. Children will have a range of options including gross motor, art, and pretend play!

Snack

We will break for snack every day. Mealtimes are a wonderful opportunity to target speech, language, and social skills.

Rotatina 1:1 with Clinician

Each child will receive 1:1 time during the day with one of the clinicians to target individual speech goals.

Lunch

Lunch time is another great opportunity to socialize.

Goodbyes

We will finish the day in a circle as well. All children must be picked at 1:00pm.

Daily Parent Communication

You will receive a brief recap of the day's activities each day.

Post Camp Report

After the camp is over, your clinician will write a short report detailing the supports given during the week and observations about your child's profile.

Insurance Reimbursement

We are able to provide <u>superbills</u> for each day of camp, meaning that up to \$775 of the camp is eligible for reimbursement using out-of-network benefits. Each day of camp can be reimbursed as the equivalent of one speech-language therapy session.

Reimbursement eligibility may vary from plan-to-plan. We encourage you to contact your insurance provider directly to determine the out-of-network benefits for your plan.

If you intend to submit superbills for reimbursement, you would pay a deposit of \$625 up front and be billed \$155/day as the camp runs.

Private Pay

If you don't plan to submit for reimbursement, you would pay in full through our website for a total of \$1400.
