WHAT TO EXPECT



"Check and See"

You don't have to just "wait and see" if your child isn't reaching milestones. When it comes to communication, we know that early support is key! After your consult, if concerns are present, speech language pathologists can evaluate and create a specific, individualized treatment plan for your child. And if waiting is, indeed, recommended, we can provide families with resources, strategies, and a specific plan to help you monitor for a set period of time.



WHAT TO EXPECT



We will schedule a convenient time for a call via email

Choose whether you prefer a phone or zoom call



We talk for either 30 minutes or 60 minutes about your child & your concerns

Payment is taken via our secure portal



Written recommendations are emailed to you within 2 business days based on our conversation

RECOMMENDATIONS

Recommendations are completely dependent on your child's profile. However, here are some possibilities that might be suggested:

MONTHLY MONITORING

Your child may not need therapy yet but that doesn't mean we want to "wait and see". We can make a plan to check in monthly to look at progress and talk about some strategies to use at home.



PARENT MODULES

If your child is an early language learner, your family may benefit from parent education through our parent modules where caregivers can learn about communication development and real strategies to support language at home



SPEECH LANGUAGE SCREEN

Your child may benefit from a complimentary 15 minute screening. The SLP will meet your child and maybe give a few basic tests to see if further testing would be needed.



EVALUATION OR TREATMENT

Based on our conversation, an evaluation or treatment may be recommended. If you are local, we can get you started with the intake process. If not, we can help you find providers in your area.



HOW TO PREPARE

Before our call, you will be asked to fill out a short intake survey so we can prepare. You'll be asked to ...

- Make a list of your child's strengths and interests
- Think about how your child currently communicates (gestures, signs, sounds, words, phrases)
- Write down the areas you are concerned about
- Gather any information from other providers (e.g., pediatrician, school, other therapists, hearing tests)
